Summer ecology camp for children at Sheldrake Environmental Center

This summer, young children can explore the mysteries of the natural world at a day camp right near home. New, more flexible program options are available at the Sheldrake Summer Ecology Camp, located at the Larchmont Reservoir Conservancy on Weaver St.

Young campers will discover the beauty and diversity of many habitats, plants and animals, through age-appropriate trail walks, stories, experiments, scavenger hunts, visiting animal specialists, crafts, "eco-dramas" and other intriguing activities designed to bring out a child's innate curiosity.

Weekly sessions may be arranged to fit a family's schedule. Scholarships are available.

Note: Special arrangements will be made for Monroe campers who are dismissed at 1:00 p.m. and wish to transfer directly into the afternoon ecology program.

For children ages 4-8

-2 days/week (Tuesday, Thursday), \$350 for members/\$375 for non-members

-3 days/week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday), \$500 for members/\$545 for non-members

-5 days/week, \$810 for members/\$860 for non-member
