Dear Teachers, welcome back to a new school year!

At Sheldrake we take a fresh look each year at how we can serve schools most effectively both in the classrooms and at our local nature sites. To assist you in educating your students, Sheldrake Environmental Center offers trained environmental educators to enhance your science curriculum. Sheldrake is fortunate to have access to an abundance of natural habitats, including shore, forest, field and wetlands. With a trained environmental educator as their guide, students will explore, discover and have fun while learning about the natural world.

Three sites are available for you to use as outdoor classrooms to educate your students. The first is set in the heart of the Sheldrake River watershed – the 60-acre expanse known as the **Larchmont Reservoir** – James G. Johnson, Jr. Conservancy, home of Sheldrake Environmental Center. Permanently protected, it is a wildlife sanctuary with lakeside trails and quiet woodland paths. The other two are **Dog Beach**, a beautiful piece of Long Island Sound shoreline, and **Sheldrake River Trail**, a forested conservation area.
